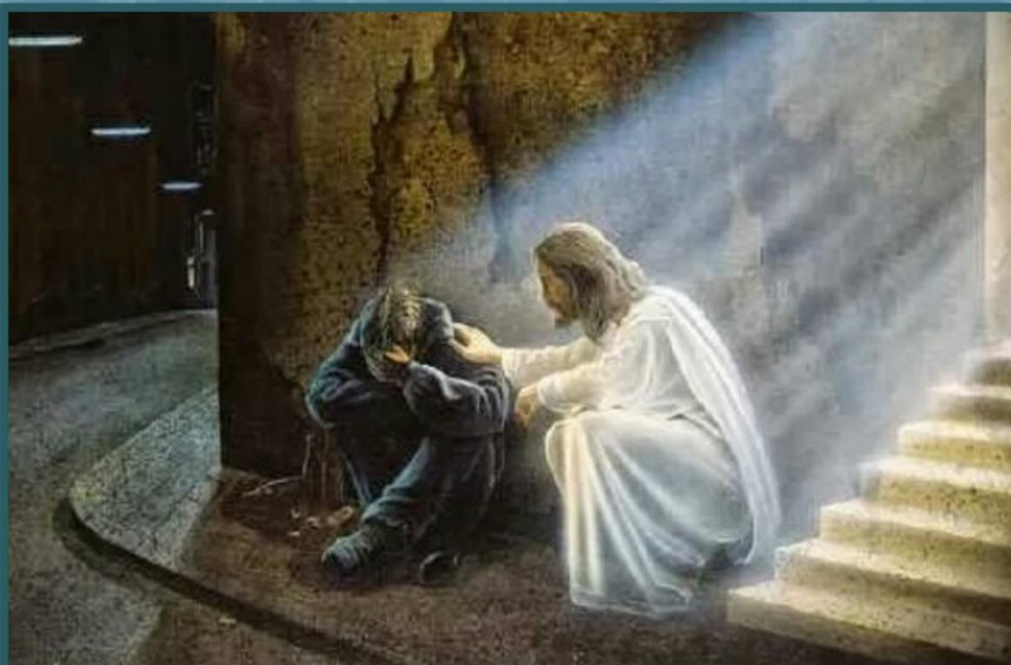

Readings and Reflection for this Sunday

*Zechariah 9:9-10 Psalm 145:1-2,8-11,13-14 Romans 8:9,11-13
Matthew 11:25-30*

Today's reading from Matthew's Gospel comes after a discourse in which Jesus reproaches people who have witnessed his mighty deeds yet still lack belief. In this context, today's Gospel explains the reason for this unbelief and reveals what is necessary for faith. Today's Gospel also continues to enhance our understanding of discipleship as last week's Gospel did.

Jesus first prays in thanksgiving to God who has made himself known to Jesus' disciples. He praises God who has made himself known to the "little ones" and not to the wise and learned. As in other recent readings from Matthew's Gospel, a contrast is made here between the unbelieving Pharisees, who are wise and learned, and the faithful disciples, tax collectors, and sinners with whom Jesus keeps company.

The second part of this reading calls to our attention the unity between the Father and the Son. God has made himself known through Jesus, and in knowing Jesus, we come to know the Father. In Jesus' life and in his person, God reveals himself to us.

In the concluding sentences of today's Gospel, Jesus' teaching is again contrasted to the teaching of the Pharisees. This common theme of Matthew's Gospel probably reflects tension that existed between Jesus and the Pharisees and between the Pharisees and the community of Christians for whom Matthew wrote. Pharisaic Judaism became the predominant form of Judaism after the destruction of the Temple in Jerusalem about 70 A.D. Here that tension is expressed as alternative paths of holiness. The careful observance of the Mosaic law taught by the Pharisees could be experienced by some as difficult and burdensome. In contrast, Jesus' way of holiness is presented as uncomplicated and even restful. Loyolapress.com

07/13-14– Adoration – Thurs from 6-7pm and Fri from 7:15-8:15am. Come spend an hour with Jesus!

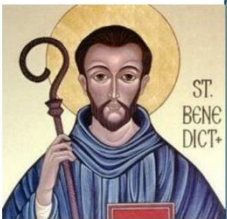
Fall in deeper love with the Eucharist!

It is "Wedding Season," so let's continue with the topic of marriage. Everyone seems to agree that Western civilization is in trouble. The problem is that no one agrees on what has gone wrong or what to do about it. Some think we have too much government, some not enough; some think we have too much capitalism, some not enough; some think we have too much sexual freedom, some not enough. But what if the problem is much more fundamental? What if the problem goes to the very foundations of who we are as human beings in relationship with God? Maybe our society's ills and its cures are rooted in whether we reject or accept the divine graces made available through the sacrament of holy matrimony. Man is social in his very nature. We were created for community. The family, formed through the sacrament of matrimony, is the most basic building block of every society - whether we like it or not. We've corrupted marriage, and so we have a corrupt society. If we get marriage right, our society, through God's grace, will flourish. This is so because matrimony, like all the sacraments, heals and elevates human nature. Without marriage, our ambitions toward a just social order will remain forever foolhardy. With it, the seemingly impossible, a truly peaceful and humane civilization, becomes possible. Lecturas Y Reflexión para este Domingo

Zacarías 9:9-10 Salmos 145:1-2,8-11,13-14 Romanos 8:9,11-13
Mateo 11:25-30

La lectura de hoy del Evangelio de Mateo viene después de un discurso en el que Jesús reprocha a las personas que han sido testigos de sus obras poderosas pero que aún carecen de creencia. En este contexto, el Evangelio de hoy explica la razón de esta incredulidad y revela lo que es necesario para la fe. El Evangelio de hoy también continúa mejorando nuestra comprensión del discipulado como lo hizo el Evangelio de la semana pasada. Jesús primero ora en acción de gracias a Dios que se ha dado a conocer a los discípulos de Jesús. Alaba a Dios que se ha dado a conocer a los "pequeños" y no a los sabios y eruditos. Como en otras lecturas recientes del Evangelio de Mateo, aquí se hace un contraste entre los fariseos incrédulos, que son sabios y eruditos, y los discípulos fieles, recaudadores de impuestos y pecadores con quienes Jesús hace compañía. La segunda parte de esta lectura llama nuestra atención sobre la unidad entre el Padre y el Hijo. Dios se ha dado a conocer a través de Jesús, y al conocer a Jesús, llegamos a conocer al Padre. En la vida de Jesús y en su persona, Dios se nos revela. En las frases finales del Evangelio de hoy, la enseñanza de Jesús se contrasta de nuevo con la enseñanza de los fariseos. Este tema común del Evangelio de Mateo probablemente refleja la tensión que existía entre Jesús y los fariseos y entre los fariseos y la comunidad de cristianos para quienes Mateo escribió. El judaísmo farisaico se convirtió en la forma predominante del judaísmo después de la destrucción del Templo en Jerusalén alrededor del año 70 d.C. Aquí esa tensión se expresa como caminos alternativos de santidad.

La cuidadosa observancia de la ley mosaica enseñada por los fariseos podría ser experimentada por algunos como difícil y onerosa. En contraste, el camino de santidad de Jesús se presenta como sencillo e incluso tranquilo. Loyolapress.com

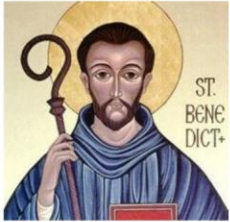
Eventos dentro de la Iglesia:
