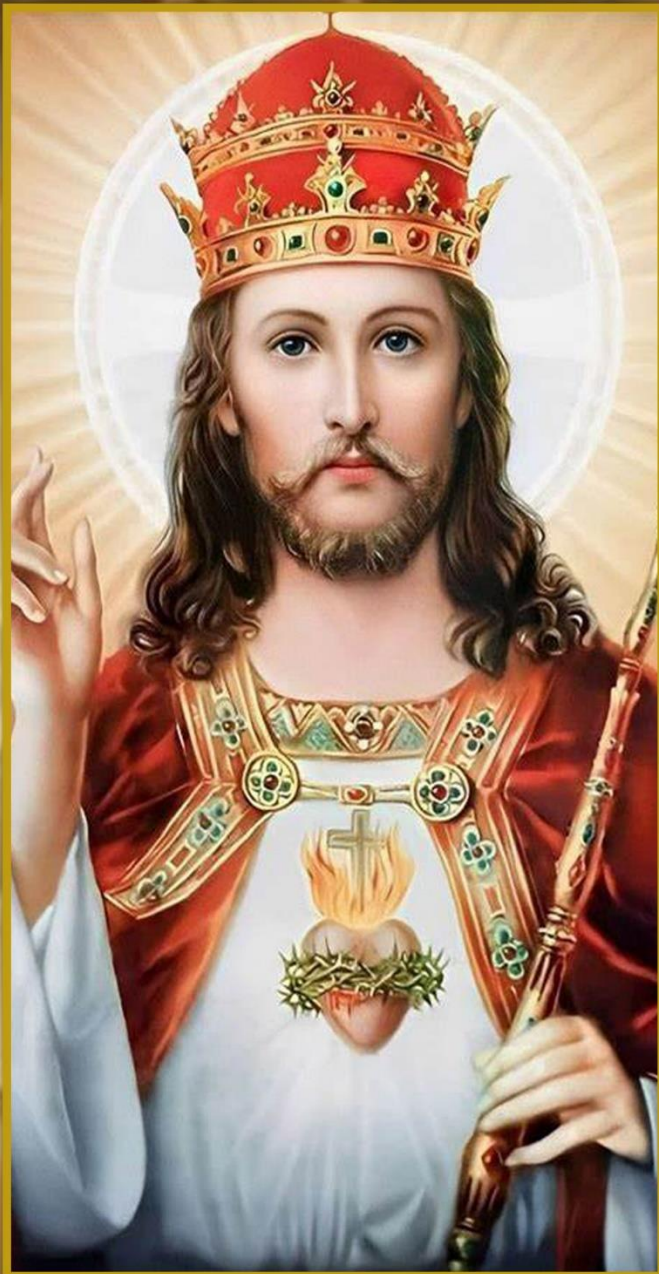

Readings and Reflection for this Sunday

Ezekiel 34:11-12,15-17 Psalm 23:1-2,2-3,5-6
Corinthians 15:20-26,28 Matthew 25:31-46

In today's Gospel, Jesus describes to his disciples the scene of the judgment of the Son of Man. All the nations will be assembled before him, and he will separate them as a shepherd separates sheep and goats upon their return from the pasture. The judgments made by the Son of Man will be based upon the acts of mercy shown to the least ones—the hungry, the thirsty, the naked, the ill, and the imprisoned. Indeed, Jesus, who suffered on the Cross, identifies himself with the least ones.

Recall that last week's parable of the talents taught us that the gifts that we have been given are intended to be used for the service of others, especially the least among us. Our judgment before God will be based not only on how we have used these gifts and talents, but also on how we have extended ourselves in service to these least ones. Indeed, Jesus tells us that whenever we have served these least ones, we have served Christ himself. When we read today's Gospel in the context of the chapters that follow in Matthew's Gospel, we learn the extent to which Jesus identifies with the least ones. In accepting death on the cross, Jesus shows himself to be one of the hungry, the naked, the ill, and the imprisoned. To accept Jesus is to accept him who suffered and died on the Cross as one of the least ones.

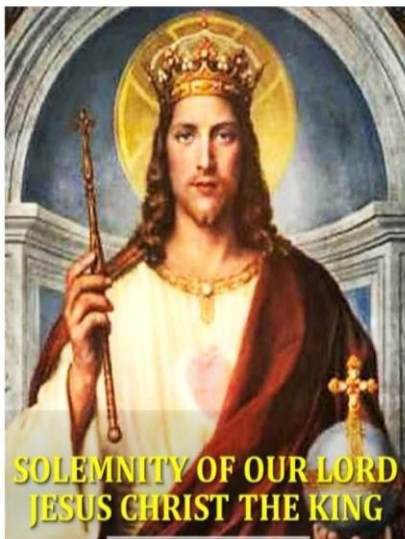

LECTURA Y REFLEXION PARA ESTE DOMINGO

Ezequiel 34:11-12,15-17 Salmos 23:1-2,2-3,5-6
Corintios 15:20-26,28 Mateo 25:31-46

En el evangelio de hoy, Jesús describe a sus discípulos la escena del juicio del Hijo del Hombre. Todas las naciones se reunirán delante de él, y él las separará como el pastor separa las ovejas y las cabras cuando regresan del pasto. Los juicios del Hijo del Hombre se basarán en los actos de misericordia mostrados hacia los más pequeños: los hambrientos, los sedientos, los desnudos, los enfermos y los encarcelados. En efecto, Jesús, que sufrió en la Cruz, se identifica con los más pequeños.

Recuerde que la parábola de los talentos de la semana pasada nos enseñó que los dones que hemos recibido están destinados a ser utilizados para el servicio de los demás, especialmente de los más pequeños entre nosotros. Nuestro juicio ante Dios se basará no sólo en cómo hemos usado estos dones y talentos, sino también en cómo nos hemos extendido al servicio de los más pequeños. De hecho, Jesús nos dice que siempre que hemos servido a estos más pequeños, hemos servido a Cristo mismo. Cuando leemos el Evangelio de hoy en el contexto de los capítulos que siguen del Evangelio de Mateo, aprendemos hasta qué punto Jesús se identifica con los más pequeños. Al aceptar la muerte en la cruz, Jesús se muestra como uno de los hambrientos, los desnudos, los enfermos y los encarcelados. Aceptar a Jesús es aceptar a Aquel que sufrió y murió en la Cruz como uno de los más pequeños.
