Readings and Reflection for this Sunday

Exodus 3:1-8, 13-15 Psalm 103:1-4, 6-8, 11 1Corinthians 10:1-6, 10-12
Luke 13:1-9

Luke tells us that some among the crowds report to Jesus a massacre of Galileans by Pilate. The intention of the crowd seems to be to ask Jesus to explain why these people suffered. It was commonplace to render people's suffering as evidence of their sinfulness. Jesus challenges this interpretation. Those who were massacred were no more or less sinful than the ones who report the situation to Jesus. Jesus replies that even a fatal accident, a natural disaster, ought not to be interpreted as punishment for sin.

Jesus' words at first appear to have a fire-and-brimstone quality. Jesus says in essence, "Repent or perish as these people did; all are sinful before God and deserving of God's punishment." The tone changes, however, in the parable that follows. The parable of the barren fig tree contrasts the patience and hopefulness of the gardener with the practicality of the property owner. When told to cut down the fig tree because it is not producing fruit, the gardener counsels patience.

If properly tended, the barren fig tree may yet bear fruit. Throughout his journey to Jerusalem, Jesus has been teaching about the Kingdom of God. In this parable, we find an image of God's patience and hopefulness as he prepares his Kingdom. God calls us to repent, and it is within his power to punish us for our failure to turn from our sinfulness. And yet God is merciful. He delays punishment and tends to us so that we may yet bear the fruit he desires from us.

This, then, is our reason for hope: Not only does God refuse to abandon us, he chooses to attend to us even when we show no evidence of his efforts. Next week's Gospel will give an even clearer picture of the kind of mercy that God shows to us.

Solemnity of the Annunciation March 25 - "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him . . . might have eternal life." (John 3:16) At the Annunciation, God revealed this good news to Mary. She was the first to hear and to believe that God would do what he promised. Her faith told her that nothing is impossible for God. Mary also heard God's invitation calling her to be the Virgin Mother of his Son. This call meant that Jesus would be formed in her womb, and she, as his mother, would nourish and care for him. This call meant that she had a special place in God's plan for salvation. Mary replied, "I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word." (Luke 1:38) In saying yes, Mary agreed to God's plan because she wanted what God wanted. She was willing to accept all the joy and pain, all the unexpected events. She was willing to bring Christ to a waiting world. 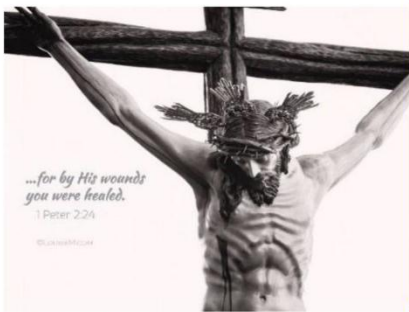

What is a Daily Examen? The Daily Examen is a technique of
prayerful reflection on the events of the day in order to detect God's
presence and discern his direction for us. The Examen is an ancient
practice in the Church that can help us see God's hand at
work in our whole experience.

The method presented here is adapted from a technique described
by Ignatius Loyola in his *Spiritual Exercises*. St. Ignatius thought that
the Examen was a gift that came directly from God, and that God
wanted it to be shared as widely as possible. One of the few rules of
prayer that Ignatius made for the Jesuit order was the requirement
that Jesuits practice the Examen twice daily—at noon and at the end
of the day. It's a habit that Jesuits, and many other
Christians, practice to this day.

The 5 steps: Become aware of God's presence, review the day with
gratitude, pay attention to your emotions, choose one feature of the
day and pray from it, and look forward to tomorrow. Lent is the
perfect time to begin this practice. For more details, see this article:

Lecturas y Reflexión para este Domingo

Éxodo 3:1-8, 13-15 Salmo 103:1-4, 6-8, 11 1Corintios 10:1-6, 10-12
Lucas 13:1-9

Lucas nos dice que algunas de las multitudes informan a Jesús de una masacre de galileos por parte de Pilato. La intención de la multitud parece ser pedirle a Jesús que explique por qué estas personas sufrieron. Era un lugar común presentar el sufrimiento de las personas como evidencia de su pecaminosidad. Jesús desafía esta interpretación. Los que fueron masacrados no eran ni más ni menos pecadores que los que informan de la situación a Jesús. Jesús responde que incluso un fatal accidente, un desastre natural, no debe interpretarse como un castigo por el pecado.

Al principio, las palabras de Jesús parecen tener una cualidad de fuego y azufre. Jesús dice en esencia: "Arrepentíos o pereced como lo hizo esta gente; todos son pecadores ante Dios y merecedores del castigo de Dios". El tono cambia, sin embargo, en la parábola que sigue. La parábola de la higuera estéril contrasta la paciencia y la esperanza del jardinero con la practicidad del dueño de la propiedad. Cuando se le dice que corte la higuera porque no está produciendo frutos, el jardinero aconseja paciencia. Si se cuida adecuadamente, la higuera estéril aún puede dar fruto. A lo largo de su viaje a Jerusalén, Jesús ha estado enseñando sobre el Reino de Dios. En esta parábola, encontramos una imagen de la paciencia y la esperanza de Dios mientras prepara su Reino. Dios nos llama a arrepentirnos, y está dentro de su poder castigarnos por no habernos apartado de nuestra pecaminosidad. Y, sin embargo, Dios es misericordioso. Él retrasa el castigo y nos atiende para que aún podamos dar el fruto que él desea de nosotros.

Esta es, entonces, nuestra razón de esperanza: Dios no solo se niega a abandonarnos, sino que elige atendernos incluso cuando no mostramos evidencia de sus esfuerzos. El Evangelio de la próxima semana dará una imagen aún más clara del tipo de misericordia que Dios nos muestra.

Al decir que sí, María estuvo de acuerdo con el plan de Dios porque quería lo que Dios quería. Estaba dispuesta a aceptar toda la alegría y el dolor, todos los acontecimientos inesperados. 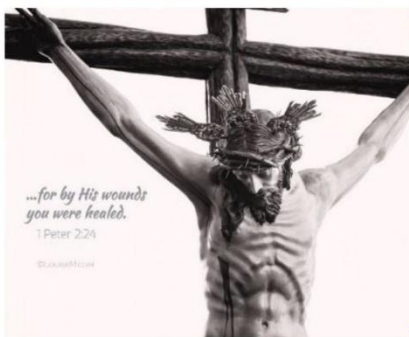

¿Qué es un Examen Diario? El Examen Diario es una técnica de reflexión orante sobre los acontecimientos del día con el fin de detectar la presencia de Dios y discernir su dirección para nosotros. El Examen es una práctica antigua en la Iglesia que puede ayudarnos a ver la mano de Dios en trabajo en toda nuestra experiencia.

El método que aquí se presenta es una adaptación de una técnica descrita por Ignacio de Loyola en sus *Ejercicios Espirituales*: San Ignacio pensaba que el Examen era un don que venía directamente de Dios, y que Dios quería que se compartiera lo más ampliamente posible. Una de las pocas reglas de oración que Ignacio hizo para la orden jesuita fue el requisito de que los jesuitas practicaran el Examen dos veces al día, al mediodía y al final del día. Es una costumbre que los jesuitas, y muchos otros. Los cristianos practican hasta el día de hoy.

Los 5 pasos: Toma conciencia de la presencia de Dios, revisa el día con gratitud, presta atención a tus emociones, elige una característica del día y ora a partir de ella, y espera con ansias el mañana.
