JUNE 1ST – THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

Readings and Reflection for this Sunday

Acts of the Apostles 1:1-11 Psalm 47:2-3,6-9 Ephesians 1:17-23 Luke 24:46-53

In the Gospels of Mark and Matthew, the disciples are sent by Jesus to baptize as well as to preach. In Luke's Gospel, however, this commission to baptize is absent. Instead, Jesus directs the disciples to return to Jerusalem to await the fulfillment of his promise to send them the Holy Spirit. Curiously, only Mark and Luke actually report Jesus' Ascension into heaven. Matthew's Gospel concludes with Jesus' promise to remain with his disciples forever. Only the Gospel of Mark notes that Jesus ascended to sit at the right hand of God. In noting this, Mark teaches that Jesus' Ascension affirms the glory

Jesus received from God after his death and Resurrection.

Those who believe in Jesus will be empowered to do what Jesus himself has done. Already in Mark's Gospel, during his ministry, Jesus sent his disciples out to preach, to heal, and to drive out unclean spirits. Now, they are sent again to do these things and more. From his place with God in heaven, Jesus helped his disciples, and he continues to help us as we try to live as his followers. Loyolapress.com

The Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord

commemorates Jesus' ascension into Heaven. Historically, this has been celebrated 40 days after Easter Sunday – the Thursday in the sixth week of Easter. Most U.S. dioceses, however, have moved the celebration of the Ascension to the seventh Sunday of Easter. For this reason, it is now often referred to as "Ascension Sunday."

The days leading up to the Ascension are full of wonder and hope. After Jesus rose from the dead, he appears first to [Mary Magdalene](#) and then to the apostles. These post-resurrection appearances are key to the Church's proclamation that Jesus Christ rose from the dead on the third day, just as he foretold (Matt. 16:21).

Lecturas y Reflexión para este Domingo

Hechos de los Apóstoles 1:1-11 Salmo 47:2-3,6-9 Efesios 1:17-23 Lucas 24:46-53

En los Evangelios de Marcos y Mateo, los discípulos son enviados por Jesús para bautizar y predicar. En el Evangelio de Lucas, Sin embargo, esta comisión de bautizar está ausente. En cambio, Jesús ordena a los discípulos que regresen a Jerusalén para esperar la cumplimiento de su promesa de enviarles el Espíritu Santo. Curiosamente, solo Marcos y Lucas informan realmente de la Ascensión de Jesús al cielo. El Evangelio de Mateo concluye con la promesa de Jesús de permanecer con sus discípulos para siempre. Sólo el Evangelio de

Marcos señala

que Jesús ascendió para sentarse a la diestra de Dios. Al notar esto, Marcos enseña que la Ascensión de Jesús afirma la gloria Jesús recibió de Dios después de su muerte y resurrección.

Aquellos que creen en Jesús tendrán el poder de hacer lo que Jesús mismo ha hecho. Ya en el Evangelio de Marcos, durante su Jesús, Jesús envió a sus discípulos a predicar, a sanar y a expulsar espíritus inmundos. Ahora, son enviados de nuevo a hacer estas cosas y más. Desde su lugar con Dios en el cielo, Jesús ayudó a sus discípulos, y continúa ayudándonos a medida que

Pascua. Por esta razón, ahora se le conoce a
menudo como el "Domingo de la Ascensión".
Los días previos a la Ascensión están llenos de
asombro y esperanza. Después de que Jesús
resucitó de entre los muertos, se aparece primero a
María Magdalena y luego a los apóstoles. Estas
apariciones posteriores a la resurrección son clave
para la proclamación de la Iglesia de que Jesucristo
resucitó de entre los muertos al tercer día, tal como
lo predijo (Mateo 16:21).
