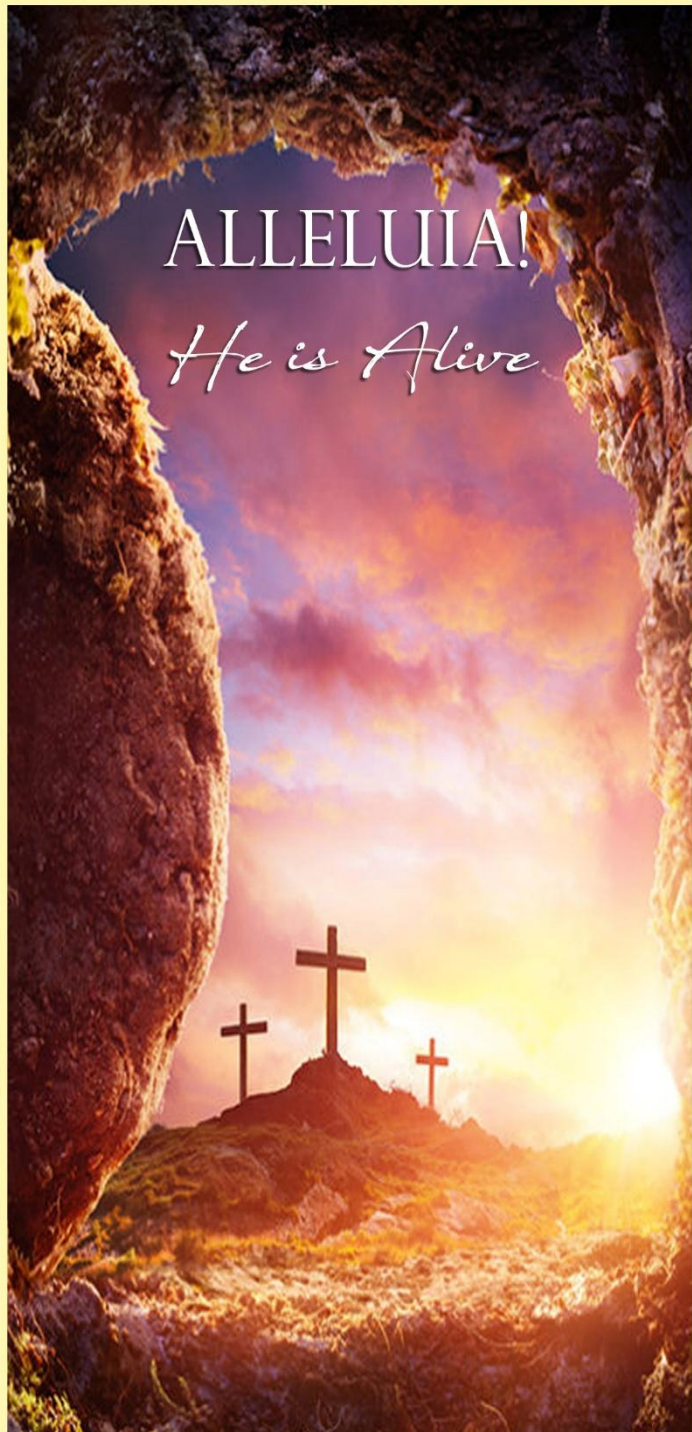

MAY 25TH – SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Readings and Reflection for this Sunday

Acts of the Apostles 15:1-2,22-29 Psalm 67:2-3,5,6,8 Revelation 21:10-14,22-23 John 14:23-29

Chapter 14 of John's Gospel actually sums up the themes of the opening of the discourse: the Christian's life is not shaped by Jesus' absence but by God's abiding presence; God's presence overcomes anxiety about God's absence; and the present holds in it the seeds of a fresh future shaped by love, not fear.

These verses also contain a glimpse of some of the other themes of the farewell discourse: Jesus' relationship with the Father and the disciples' relationship to Jesus connect the disciples to the Father as well. Jesus promises to send an Advocate or intercessor who will remind the disciples of everything that Jesus taught them and bring them peace.

Jesus is preparing his disciples in advance for his absence so that they will continue to believe in him and not feel all alone after his return to the Father. After the initial excitement of his Easter appearances, Jesus will remain with his followers in a very different way throughout the centuries. As our celebration of the Easter season is coming to an end, the liturgy reminds us that Jesus remains with us through the Holy Spirit, who teaches us everything we need to know, reminds us of all that Jesus taught, and brings us peace. 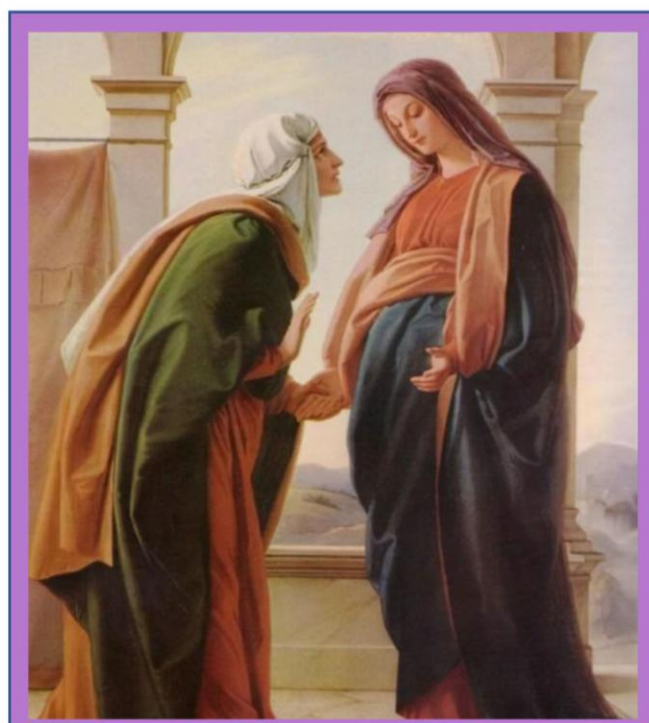
Annual Women's Retreat Sept 12-14

THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD MAY 29 CELEBRATED ON JUNE 1

Jesus' time on earth began with his birth. It was interrupted for three days by His death on the Cross. During that time, He descended into the realm of the dead and preached the Gospel to the good people who died before Him. On the third day after his death and burial, Jesus Christ was raised from the dead, an event we call the Resurrection. He spent the next 40 days preaching and preparing His disciples to perform the work of preaching and baptizing all people. At the end of this 40 day period, Jesus ascended into heaven. We call this the Ascension.

Lecturas y Reflexión para este Domingo

Hechos de los Apóstoles 15:1-2,22-29 Salmo 67:2-3,5,6,8 Apocalipsis 21:10-14,22-23 Juan 14:23-29

De hecho, el capítulo 14 del Evangelio de Juan resume los temas de apertura del discurso: la vida del cristiano no está determinada por la ausencia de Jesús, sino por la presencia permanente de Dios; La presencia de Dios supera la ansiedad por la ausencia de Dios; Y el presente contiene las semillas de un nuevo futuro moldeado por el amor, no por el miedo. Estos versículos también contienen un vistazo de algunos de los otros temas del discurso de despedida: la relación de Jesús con el Padre y la relación de los discípulos con Jesús conectan a los discípulos con el Padre también. Jesús promete enviar un Abogado o intercesor que recordará a los discípulos todo lo que Jesús les enseñó y les traerá la paz. Jesús está preparando a sus discípulos de antemano para su ausencia, para que continúen creyendo en él y no se sientan solos después de su regreso al Padre. Después de la emoción inicial de sus apariciones en Pascua, Jesús permanecerá con sus seguidores de una manera muy diferente a lo largo de los siglos. A medida que nuestra celebración de la temporada de Pascua llega a su fin, la liturgia nos recuerda que Jesús permanece con nosotros a través del Espíritu Santo, quien nos enseña todo lo que necesitamos saber, nos recuerda todo lo que Jesús enseñó y nos trae paz.

ASCENSIÓN DEL SEÑOR

"ID AL MUNDO ENTERO Y
PROCLAMAD EL EVANGELIO"
(JN 16. 15)

LA ASCENSIÓN DEL SEÑOR: 29 DE MAYO, CELEBRADA EL 1 DE JUNIO

El tiempo de Jesús en la tierra comenzó con su nacimiento. Fue interrumpida durante tres días por su muerte en la cruz. Durante ese tiempo, descendió al reino de los muertos y predicó el Evangelio a las buenas personas que murieron antes que Él. Al tercer día después de su muerte y sepultura, Jesucristo resucitó de entre los muertos, un evento que llamamos la Resurrección. Pasó los siguientes 40 días predicando y preparando a sus discípulos para llevar a cabo la obra de predicar y bautizar a todas las personas. Al final de este período de 40 días, Jesús ascendió al cielo. A esto lo llamamos la Ascensión.

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
