JULY 13TH - FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Readings and Reflection for this Sunday Deuteronomy 30:10-14 Psalm 69:14,17,30-31,36-37 Colossians 1:15-20 Luke 10:25-37

The road from Jerusalem to Jericho descends 3,300 feet in just 17 miles. Its narrow passes and rocky terrain made it an easy place for bandits to wait for travelers. The traveler in this parable is identified only as "a certain man." Luke uses this phrase in many of his parables so that the audience, Jew or Gentile, could identify with the man. After the attack, the man is left for dead, naked and bleeding on the side of the road. A priest comes along, but rather than helping, as one might expect, he moves to the other side of the road. Another religious person comes along, a Levite who assists in the Temple. His reaction is the same as the priest's. Both of them choose to not even find out if the man is alive. A third person comes along. The listeners would probably expect him to be an Israelite. This would make the parable a criticism of the religious leadership. Instead, he is a Samaritan, an Israelite's most hated neighbor. Samaritans were descendants of Jews from the northern part of the country, who had intermarried with Gentiles and did not worship in Jerusalem. The Samaritan not only goes over to the injured man but cleans his wounds, puts him on his own animal, takes him to an inn to recover, and promises to pay all his expenses. The hated enemy is the compassionate neighbor in this parable. When Jesus asks the lawyer who was the neighbor in the story, the lawyer can't bring himself to say it was the Samaritan. All he says is that it was "the one who treated him with mercy." Jesus' response was similar to that of the first discussion: "Go and do likewise." The lawyer, and we, know what is right. The key is to do it. Loyolapress.com

Our Lady of Mt. Carmel July 16

According to tradition, the scapular of Carmel was presented to St. Simon Stock in the 13th century during a period of severe oppression of the Carmelite Order. The Blessed Mother appeared to him as an apparition and said to him: "Receive, my beloved son, this scapular of thy Order; it is the special sign of my favor, which I have obtained for thee and for thy children of Mount Carmel. He who dies clothed with this habit shall be preserved from eternal fire. It is the badge of salvation, a shield in time of danger, and a pledge of special peace and protection."

The scapular has become a widely used devotion, with special significance in its offering of protection, as well as in its purpose of becoming a "habit" of Christian conduct.

13 DE JULIO - DECIMOQUINTO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO

Lecturas y Reflexión para este Domingo Deuteronomio 30:10-14 Salmo 69:14,17,30-31,36-37 Colosenses 1:15-20 Lucas 10:25-37

El camino de Jerusalén a Jericó desciende 3,300 pies en solo 17 millas. Sus pasos estrechos y su terreno rocoso lo convertían en un lugar fácil para que los bandidos esperaran a los viajeros. El viajero en esta parábola es identificado solo como "cierto hombre". Lucas usa esta frase en muchas de sus parábolas para que la audiencia, judía o gentil, pudiera identificarse con el hombre. Después del ataque, el hombre es dado por muerto, desnudo y sangrando a un lado de la carretera. Llega un sacerdote, pero en lugar de ayudar, como cabría esperar, se traslada al otro lado de la carretera. Viene otra persona religiosa, un levita que ayuda en el Templo. Su reacción es la misma que la del sacerdote. Ambos optan por ni siquiera averiguar si el hombre está vivo. Llega una tercera persona. Los oyentes probablemente esperarían que él fuera un israelita. Esto haría de la parábola una crítica al liderazgo religioso. En cambio, es un samaritano, el vecino más odiado de un israelita. Los samaritanos eran descendientes de judíos de la parte norte del país, que se habían casado con gentiles y no adoraban en Jerusalén. El samaritano no solo se acerca al hombre herido, sino que limpia sus heridas, lo monta en su propio animal, lo lleva a una posada para que se recupere y promete pagar todos sus gastos. El enemigo odiado es el vecino compasivo de esta parábola. Cuando Jesús le pregunta al abogado quién era el vecino de la historia, el abogado no se atreve a decir que era el samaritano. Todo lo que dice es que fue "el que lo trató con misericordia". La respuesta de Jesús fue similar a la de la primera conversación: "Ve y haz lo mismo". El abogado, y nosotros, sabemos lo que es correcto. La clave es hacerlo. Loyolapress.com
