Readings and Reflection for this Sunday

Wisdom 18:6-9 Psalm 33:1,12,18-22 Hebrews 11:1-2, 8-19 Luke 12:32-48

The antidote for the anxiety brought on by the coming judgment is to relinquish our possessions and provide for the needs of others. Our treasure will be in heaven where it will not wear out or be destroyed.

The other major way to be ready for the coming judgment is to be watchful. In Luke's Gospel, Jesus tells a parable about watchfulness to begin making this point. We must be like servants waiting for the master's return from a wedding banquet, which, even now, can last for a few days in the Middle East. We must be watchful so that even if the master comes after midnight, we will be ready for him. This is what the coming of the Son of Man will be like.

Peter asks if this parable is meant for the apostles or for the large crowd that has gathered to listen to Jesus. Without answering Peter's question, Jesus responds with another parable about servants awaiting the return of their master. It begins with a question: "Who, then, is the faithful and prudent steward whom the master will put in charge of his servants to distribute the food allowance at the proper time?" This parable adds to the theme of watchfulness; it explains how to wait and reminds us of the reward for the faithful follower at the heavenly banquet after the judgment. If it is addressed to the apostles, then it could also be addressed to leadership in the early Church. Either way, the parables remind us that we should be found doing our jobs when the master arrives. If we are doing our jobs, our reward will be great. But if we relax, neglect our duties, and begin to act like the greedy rich man—eating, drinking, and making merry—we will not have a place in the kingdom. Watchfulness means living in such a consistently moral and obedient way that we are always ready to give an account to God of how we have lived.

Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary - On November 1, 1950, Pope Pius XII defined the Assumption of Mary to be a dogma of faith: "We pronounce, declare and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma that the immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul to heavenly glory." The pope proclaimed this dogma only after a broad consultation of bishops, theologians and laity. There were few dissenting voices. What the pope solemnly declared was already a common belief in the Catholic Church. We find homilies on the Assumption going back to the sixth century. In following centuries, the Eastern Churches held steadily to the doctrine, but some authors in the West were hesitant. However by the 13th century there was universal agreement. The feast was celebrated under various names—Commemoration, Dormition, Passing, Assumption—from at least the fifth or sixth century. Today it is celebrated as a solemnity. Scripture does not give an account of Mary's assumption into heaven. Nevertheless, Revelation 12 speaks of a woman who is caught up in the battle between good and evil. Many see this woman as God's people. Since Mary best embodies the people of both Old and New Testaments, her assumption can be seen as an exemplification of the woman's victory. Furthermore, in 1 Corinthians 15:20, Paul speaks of Christ's resurrection as the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep. Since Mary is closely associated with all the mysteries of Jesus' life, it is not surprising that the Holy Spirit has led the Church to believe in Mary's share in his glorification. So close was she to Jesus on earth, she must be with him body and soul in heaven. Celebrate Aug. 15!

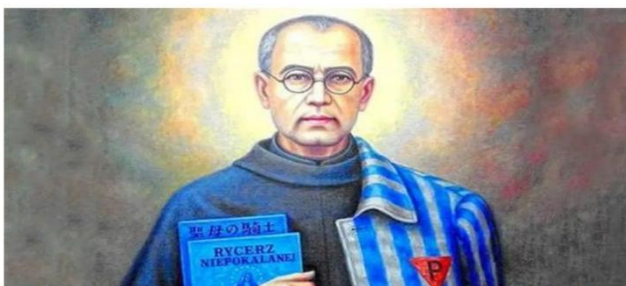
Lecturas y Reflexión para este domingo

Sabiduría 18:6-9 Salmo 33:1,12,18-22 hebreos 11:1-2, 8-19 Lucas 12:32-48

El antídoto para la ansiedad provocada por el juicio venidero es renunciar a nuestras posesiones y proveer para las necesidades de los demás. Nuestro tesoro estará en el cielo, donde no se desgastará ni será destruido.

La otra forma importante de estar preparado para el juicio venidero es estar atento. En el Evangelio de Lucas, Jesús cuenta una parábola sobre la vigilancia para comenzar a hacer este punto. Debemos ser como sirvientes que esperan el regreso del amo de un banquete de bodas, que, incluso ahora, puede durar unos días en el Medio Oriente. Debemos estar atentos para que, incluso si el maestro llega después de la medianoche, estemos listos para él. Así será la venida del Hijo del Hombre. Pedro pregunta si esta parábola está destinada a los apóstoles o a la gran multitud que se ha reunido para escuchar a Jesús. Sin responder a la pregunta de Pedro, Jesús responde con otra parábola sobre los siervos que esperan el regreso de su amo. Comienza con una pregunta: "¿Quién, entonces, es el mayordomo fiel y prudente a quien el amo pondrá a cargo de sus siervos para distribuir la ración de alimentos en el momento apropiado?" Esta parábola se suma al tema de la vigilancia; Explica cómo esperar y nos recuerda la recompensa para el fiel seguidor en el banquete celestial después del juicio. Si está dirigido a los apóstoles, entonces también podría estar dirigido al liderazgo en la Iglesia primitiva. De cualquier manera, las parábolas nos recuerdan que deberíamos encontrarnos haciendo nuestro trabajo cuando llegue el amo. Si estamos haciendo nuestro trabajo, nuestra recompensa será grande. Pero si nos relajamos, descuidamos nuestros deberes y comenzamos a actuar como el rico codicioso, comiendo, bebiendo y divirtiendonos, no tendremos un lugar en el reino. La vigilancia significa vivir de una manera tan consistentemente moral y obediente que siempre estemos listos para dar cuenta a Dios de cómo hemos vivido. Loyolapress.com

Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María - El 1 de noviembre de 1950, el Papa Pío XII definió la Asunción de María como un dogma de fe: "Pronunciamos, declaramos y definimos como un dogma divinamente revelado que la Inmaculada Madre de Dios, la siempre Virgen María, habiendo completado el curso de su vida terrenal, fue asunta en cuerpo y alma a la gloria celestial". El Papa proclamó este dogma solo después de una amplia consulta de obispos, teólogos y laicos. Hubo pocas voces disidentes. Lo que el Papa declaró solemnemente ya era una creencia común en la Iglesia Católica. Encontramos homilías sobre la Asunción que se remontan al siglo VI. En los siglos siguientes, las Iglesias orientales se mantuvieron firmes en la doctrina, pero algunos autores en Occidente dudaron. Sin embargo, en el siglo XIII hubo un acuerdo universal. La fiesta se celebraba con varios nombres: Conmemoración, Dormición, Paso, Asunción, desde al menos el siglo V o VI. Hoy se celebra como una solemnidad. Las Escrituras no dan cuenta de la asunción de María al cielo. Sin embargo, Apocalipsis 12 habla de una mujer que está atrapada en la batalla entre el bien y el mal. Muchos ven a esta mujer como el pueblo de Dios. Dado que María encarna mejor a las personas del Antiguo y Nuevo Testamento, su asunción puede verse como un ejemplo de la victoria de la mujer. Además, en 1 Corintios 15:20, Pablo habla de la resurrección de Cristo como las primicias de los que han dormido. Dado que María está estrechamente asociada con todos los misterios de la vida de Jesús, no es sorprendente que el Espíritu Santo haya llevado a la Iglesia a creer en la participación de María en su glorificación. Tan cerca estaba de Jesús en la tierra, que debía estar con él en cuerpo y alma en el cielo. ¡Celebra el 15 de agosto!
