## Readings and Reflection for this Sunday

*Ezekiel 37:12-14 Psalm 130:1-8 Romans 8:8-11 John 11:1-45*

Today's Gospel reading recounts another sign, or miracle, found in John's Gospel, the raising of Lazarus. As our catechumens move closer to the celebration of their Baptisms at the Triduum, today's reading invites us to reflect upon what it means to call Jesus the Resurrection and the life. The context for the story of the raising of Lazarus is the Jewish leaders' growing animosity toward Jesus. Jesus has been in Jerusalem, taking part in the feast of the Dedication, which we have come to know as Hanukkah. The people have been pressing him to declare plainly whether he is the Messiah. Jesus tells them to look to his works, which testify to his coming from God. Many do not believe Jesus, however, and some try to stone him for blasphemy. Into this scene of confrontation, Mary and Martha, the sisters of Lazarus, send word to Jesus that his friend is ill. Jesus is said to love Mary, Martha, and Lazarus, but he delays his journey for two days. The delay heightens the drama and shows Jesus' obedience to God, who is to be glorified through Lazarus's resurrection. When Jesus finally declares that he will journey to Bethany, his disciples fear for his life. Thomas declares that he and the other disciples should prepare to die with Jesus. The scene described at Bethany is a sad one. Martha meets Jesus weeping and saying that if Jesus had been there, Lazarus would not have died. Yet she remains confident that God will do whatever Jesus asks. Martha affirms her belief that there will be a resurrection of the dead in the last days. Then Martha's sister, Mary, comes to Jesus with the same confidence, saying that Jesus could have cured Lazarus. Jesus asks to be brought to Lazarus's tomb where he prays and calls Lazarus out from the tomb. At this sign, many come to believe in Jesus, but others take word of the miracle to the Jewish authorities, who begin their plans for Jesus' death. Set against the backdrop of Jesus' impending death, many elements of the raising of Lazarus foreshadow the good news of Jesus' own Resurrection. Jesus, facing the conflict with the Jewish authorities, acts in complete obedience to God. In raising Lazarus, Jesus shows his power over death so that when Jesus dies, those who believe in him might remember that and take hope. Just as Jesus calls for the stone to be rolled away from Lazarus's tomb, so too will the disciples find the stone rolled away from Jesus' tomb. With our catechumens preparing for their Baptism at Easter, the Gospel today calls us to reflect on Baptism as a dying and rising with Jesus. Loyolapress.com

Though the word "scrutinize" sounds negative, even intimidating, its true meaning is simply "to see clearly or inspect closely." The Scrutinies are about *seeing sin in its right aspect, and coming to understand the way we fall victim to it. ## Passiontide

Prior to the revision of the liturgical calendar in 1969, **Passiontide** refers to the last two weeks of Lent, beginning on the **Fifth Sunday of Lent** and ending on Holy Saturday.

This period commemorates the increasing revelation of Christ's Divinity and His movement towards Jerusalem.



Under the older, two-week Passiontide, all statues and crosses in the church were veiled in purple on Passion Sunday (i.e., 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Lent) and remained covered until Easter Vigil night.

There will be **NO CONFESSION** the weekend of Easter. Please schedule something with Father Jeff

## Lecturas y reflexión para este domingo

*Ezequiel 37:12-14 Salmo 130:1-8 Romanos 8:8-11 Juan 11:1-45*

La lectura del Evangelio de hoy relata otra señal, o milagro, que se encuentra en el Evangelio de Juan: la resurrección de Lázaro. A medida que nuestros catecúmenos se acercan a la celebración de sus bautismos en el Triduo, la lectura de hoy nos invita a reflexionar sobre lo que significa llamar a Jesús la Resurrección y la vida. El contexto de la historia de la resurrección de Lázaro es la creciente animosidad de los líderes judíos hacia Jesús. Jesús ha estado en Jerusalén, participando en la fiesta de la Dedicación, que hemos llegado a conocer como Janucá. La gente le ha estado presionando para que declare claramente si es el Mesías. Jesús les dice que miren a sus obras, que dan testimonio de su venida de Dios. Sin embargo, muchos no creen en Jesús y algunos intentan apedrearlo por blasfemia. En esta escena de enfrentamiento, María y Marta, hermanas de Lázaro, envían a Jesús la noticia de que su amigo está enfermo. Se dice que Jesús ama a María, Marta y Lázaro, pero retrasa su viaje dos días. El retraso intensifica el drama y muestra la obediencia de Jesús a Dios, que será glorificado mediante la resurrección de Lázaro. Cuando Jesús finalmente declara que viajará a Betania, sus discípulos temen por su vida. Tomás declara que él y los demás discípulos deben prepararse para morir con Jesús. La escena descrita en Bethany es una triste. Marta se encuentra con Jesús llorando y diciendo que si Jesús hubiera estado allí, Lázaro no habría muerto. Sin embargo, sigue confiada en que Dios hará todo lo que Jesús le pida. Martha reafirma su creencia de que habrá una resurrección de los muertos en los últimos días. Entonces la hermana de Marta, María, se acerca a Jesús con la misma confianza, diciendo que Jesús podría haber curado a Lázaro. Jesús pide ser llevado a la tumba de Lázaro, donde reza y llama a Lázaro fuera de la tumba. Ante este signo, muchos llegan a creer en Jesús, pero otros llevan la noticia del milagro a las autoridades judías, que comienzan sus planes para la muerte de Jesús. Ambientado en el contexto de la inminente muerte de Jesús, muchos elementos de la resurrección de Lázaro anticipan las buenas nuevas de la propia Resurrección de Jesús. Jesús, ante el conflicto con las autoridades judías, actúa en completa obediencia a Dios. Al resucitar a Lázaro, Jesús muestra su poder sobre la muerte para que, cuando Jesús muera, quienes creen en él puedan recordar Eso y tomar la esperanza. Así como Jesús pide que la piedra sea arrastrada lejos de la tumba de Lázaro, los discípulos también encontrarán la piedra rodada lejos de la tumba de Jesús. Con nuestros catecúmenos preparándose para su bautismo en Pascua, el Evangelio de hoy nos llama a reflexionar sobre el bautismo como un morir y resucitar con Jesús. Loyolapress.com
